Lyn Paul Taylor was born in 1944, in Fort Collins, Colorado. He spent his formative years in various towns and cities in Colorado, New Mexico, Utah, and northern California. He received a bachelor degree from San Jose State University, and a master's degree in Physical Therapy from the University of Southern California. Graduating in 1971, he began his professional career as a junior physical therapist at Kaiser Hospital in Los Angeles. After several years, he entered private practice in Los Angeles, founding and developing the Biofeedback and Advanced Therapy Institute (currently named the Advanced Therapy Institute). He has authored various books, including *Electromyometric Biofeedback Therapy, Physical Evaluation & Treatment,* and *Physical Therapy in the Paddock.* He was the co-developer of the DSR Zone Finder®, and one of the inventors of IBTC®, an ibuprofen topical treatment for sub dermal inflammation.

Mr. Taylor has spent the last 40+ years developing his approach to the care and treatment of soft tissue injuries, which has culminated in this text and an in-house professional training program, both under the name of *The Taylor Technique of Soft Tissue Management*.
